JOHN S. KNIGHT MEMORIAL JOURNALISM FUND**

The John S. Knight Memorial Journalism Fund Inc. annually awards scholarships to college journalism, public relations and communications students, with preference given to students from Summit, Portage, Medina, Stark and Wayne counties. The scholarships are awarded in memory of John S. Knight, longtime editor of the Akron Beacon Journal and founder of Knight Ridder newspapers. Another scholarship honors the memory of longtime public relations professional and professor Ludel Sauvageot.

This year, five students each will be awarded a \$5,000 Knight scholarship. One will win the \$5,000 Sauvageot scholarship. Another student will receive the Russ Pry scholarship, a memorial scholarship for the late Summit County executive, for \$5,000 sponsored by the Akron Press Club, which will also award two additional \$5,000 scholarships through the generosity of Dr. Aileen Thong.

Scholarship guidelines are as follows:

1. The applicant must be active in any facet of journalism and/or public relations. Applicants must be in good academic standing at a college or university.
2. The applicant should be a freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in the fall of 2021
3. Financial need will be considered.
4. Previous John S. Knight or Ludel Sauvageot scholarship winners will be considered.

These are guidelines only and are not intended to limit the discretion of the fund.

The scholarship committee of the John S. Knight Memorial Journalism Fund and the Akron Press Club has the responsibility of soliciting applications, screening candidates and making recommendations to the board of trustees of the John S. Knight Memorial Journalism Fund Inc. The board has the sole authority for the awarding of the scholarships. Questions can be directed to jsknightscholars@gmail.com or (330) 800-0236.

 - Photojournalist entries: Direct judges to your digital portfolio link.
 - Please make sure that we receive the correct and working link as it will be the judges only means of screening your work. We do not accept discs or tapes.

- A small head shot of yourself (black and white or color; be sure your name is on the back)
